Bob's 1st deer in 32 years. 2005 2002 & 2002 hunting seasons were spent hunting out of "Old Blue" wherever Mark Hess guided Marty Lehman & Tiffany Thoma to back in off the beaten path at St. Marie. Unfortunately not many pictures were taken & a lot of practice shots took place for Bob.

Winter Heise, a 14-year old Oshkosh student, joined the BMC hunting opportunity in 2003 st St. Marie with her father Jerry. Winter was diagnosed in 1999 with a brain cyst & in 2004 with a nerve degeneration disease. She shot a small buck to doe in 2003, but unfortunately we didn't get any pictures.

unfortunately Winter was not able to place her tag on any of them. She was able to get a doe on the last evening though!!





James suffered a stroke at age 5, which affected his left side.





In 2005, BMC decided it was important to get the hunters together to share the hunting stories & pictures. James presented Mark Hess with a picture of the 2 of them.

Harold was unable to get a buck in 2011, but that doesn't mean he didn't fill his freezer. He took down 3 does. No pictures so we had to use an old one.






