Aside from sitting in the woods and fields, hunters at BMC's properties also share meals and strike friendships with many of the BMC Associates who volunteer to help each year. Over the 20 years, BMC has touched 106 different individuals and even though many hunters found success this year, the deer is really a bonus! "Regardless of whether they get a deer or not, all the hunters come out of this special program with smiles, new friendships and memories that last a lifetime," says Tiffany Thoma, BMC Environmental Team and Special Hunt Team Leader. "And when the hunt is over in October each year, you cannot help but get excited for next year's season after hearing the stories and the memories made by each and every participant. 
