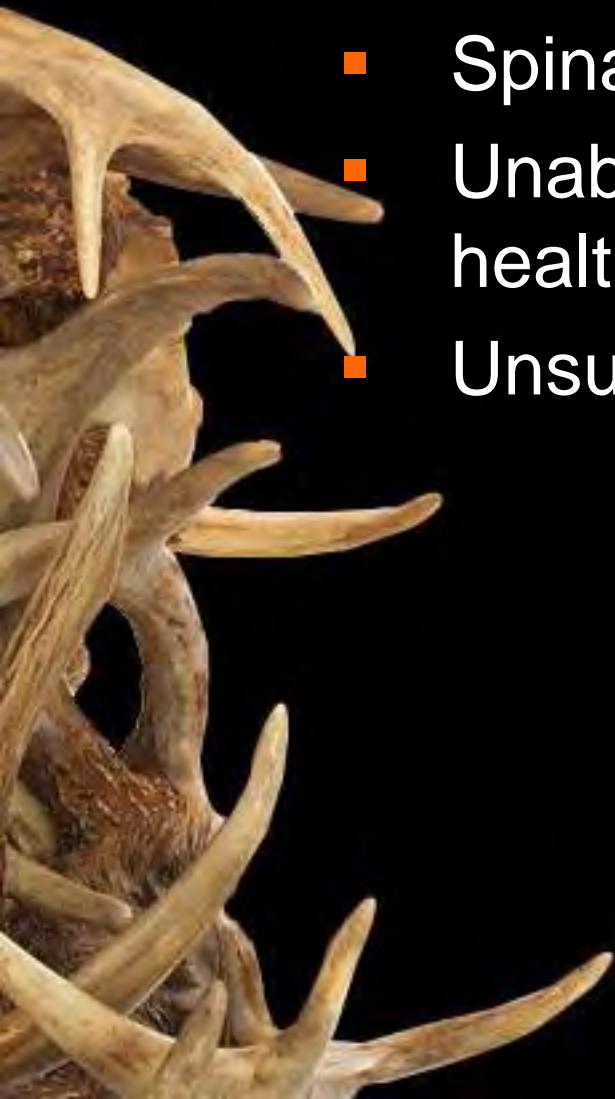
I was blessed with the help of these guys to be able to harvest a really nice eight point buck! I'm looking forward to enjoying this experience further at the dinner table.

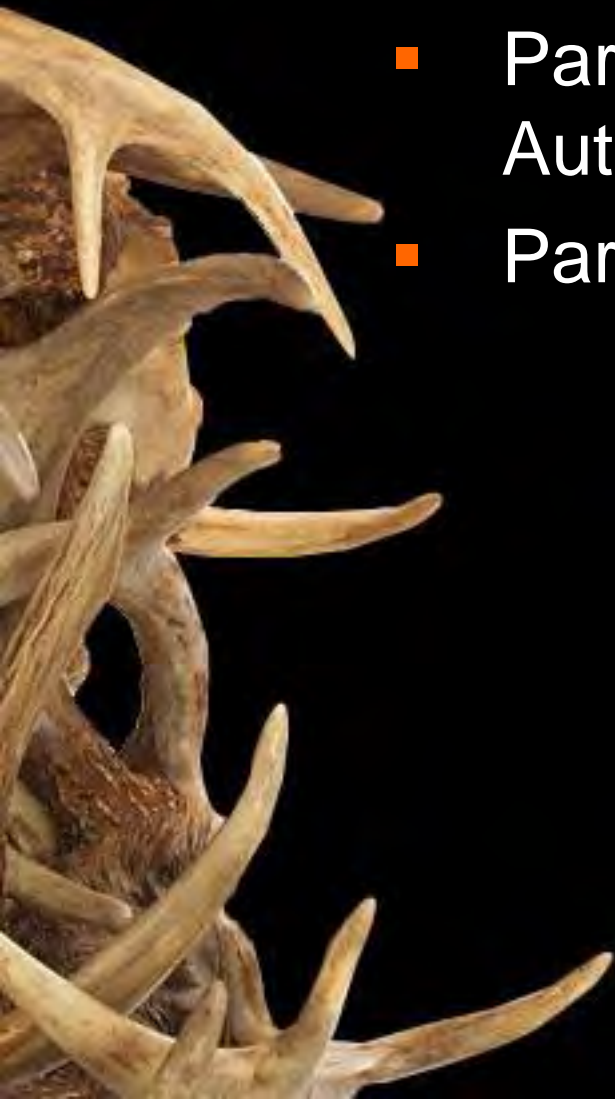

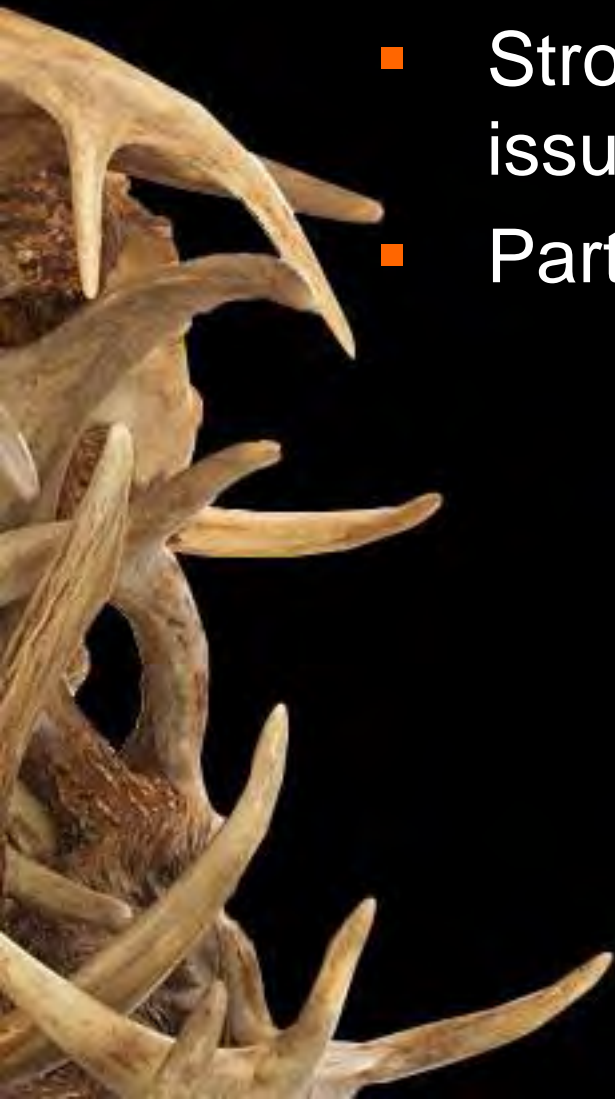
